

## Medals Exhibition Activity

Now that they have found out more about their person, students can build an exhibition about them.

In their envelopes each group a Medals Exhibition Tool that describes three themes that their exhibition will be divided into. They can use the pop-out icons to label the objects and organise them into themes.

Students may have different opinions around how they organise the evidence! Items can have more than one category assigned to them. Encourage the students to talk about how they categorised their objects.
